Score:



Ask the student to look at the photo of the chocolate bar. Ask: What does it taste like? (sweet, delicious, etc.) Then ask: When was the last time you tasted something sour/spicy/raw/terrible?, etc. Encourage the student to talk about this experience.



Challenge:

Invite the student to talk about where chocolate is produced (Dominican Republic, Peru, Mexico, Brazil, etc.). Elicit a famous product from the student's country and if applicable, ask what material it's made of.

2 Point to the photo of children studying an imitation of the human brain and ask: What are they studying? (science/biology). Elicit other school subjects the student has and what he/she learns at each one.



Challenge:

Invite the student to talk about his favorite school subject and what he/she has learnt recently.

3 Draw the student's attention to the photos of Big Ben and of the Great Sphinx of Giza and elicit their location (London, UK and Cairo, Egypt). Ask the student which of the two world-famous places he/she would like to visit most and why. Encourage the student to talk about other famous landmarks/monuments/ structures he/she has already been to.



Challenge:

Ask the student if he/she knows anything about the mystery surrounding the Great Sphinx of Giza and the Great Pyramids that are visible in the background. Ask: Do you know any other unsolved mysteries or unexplained phenomena? Encourage the student to talk about which one he/she finds the most interesting and why.
